- ·solution=Jewishstate under patronage of imperial power
- · Weaponized anti-semitism to justify colonial agendas

>5mil. Jews emigrate from Eastern Eur.few thousand to Palestine

Zionism begins to grow (previously a few fanatical religious sects)

1880-1914

~75.000 Jews migrate to Palestine-less than 1% Jews worldwide

(1914-1918) World War I

Colonial Expansion & Zionist seizure of Indigenous Land

Balfour Declaration

Formal support by British gov't of nat'l home for Jews in Palestine

1918 British Colonialism in Palestine

Privileged small Jewish population over Palestinians

1936 Great Arab Revolt

Zionists create armed militias. the Haganah, to help British repression

(1941-1945) HOLOCAUST OF 6 MIL. JEWS

legitimized Zionist claims to land



·>500 villages destroyed

·>750.000 Palestinians displaced

·15,000 Pal. killed

extent still being unearthed, ~ largely blc Israel censorship

·ongoing genocide, apartheid, settler violence, & resistance
